

From 8th – 10th May, 2017, the 2nd Meeting of Congress of Southeast Asian Librarians (CONSAL) XVII has taken place in Yangon (Myanmar) with the participation of more than 23 delegates from 9 country members: Brunei, Cambodia, Indonesia, Malaysia, Myanmar, Philippines, Singapore, Thailand and Viet Nam. Vietnamese delegation attending the 2nd Meeting includes 02 delegates from the National Library of Viet Nam.

This is the 2nd Meeting of CONSAL Executive Board XVII, following the 1st Meeting which was taken place in May, 2016. Besides annual activities like the adoption of the 1st

Meeting minutes, reports on operational updates from country members, reports on progress of regional joint programs... At this meeting, the host country Myanmar reported the preparation work, as well as asked the members of the Executive Board about the content of 2018 CONSAL XVII General Assembly.
