

On the afternoon of August 18, 2022, the Ambassador of the Republic of Belarus to Viet Nam, Mr. Vladimir Baravikov paid a working visit to the National Library of Viet Nam (NLV). Ms. Kieu Thuy Nga, Director of the NLV received the delegation.

At the meeting, the Director congratulated Ambassador Vladimir Baravikov on his new duty in Viet Nam and took time to briefly introduce the National Library of Viet Nam as well as cooperation activities between the NLV and the Embassy of the Republic of Belarus over the past time.

Ms. Kieu Thuy Nga welcomed the goodwill of Ambassador Vladimir Baravikov and affirmed that the NLV is willing to cooperate with the Embassy of the Republic of Belarus in organizing cultural events at the library, bringing opportunity for library users in particular and the public, in general, to learn about the unique features of the culture, country, and people of Belarus. At the same time, she stressed that the activity is even more meaningful when it is held in the year of the 30th anniversary of the establishment of diplomatic relations between the two countries. The two sides then agreed to continue to discuss it in more detail and have a specific implementation plan in the coming time.
