On the morning of June 19, 2020, Mr. Chékou Oussouman, Director of the Asia – Pacific Region, International Organization of La Francophonie (OIF) visited and worked with the National Library of Viet Nam. Ms. Kieu Thuy Nga, Director of the National Library of Viet Nam (NLV) received the delegation.

At the meeting, NLV Director respectfully welcomed the newly appointed Director of the Asia-Pacific Region of OIF and expressed her belief that Mr. Chékou Oussouman would help promote the cooperation relation between the National Library of Viet Nam and the International Organization of La Francophonie in the coming time. The two sides spent time discussing about content of the framework agreement of the Francophone Book Space project. This is a project of OIF started in 2012 with the goal of strenghthening the public library network in Francophone countries by sponsoring books to be published locally and translated into French, or works written on topics directly related to that country. The project has been implemented in Ghana, Seychelles, Guinée, Arménie; and Viet Nam is expected to be the 5 th country of the project, the NLV is proposed to participate as the main partner with the role of managing and implementing the project in Viet Nam. The two leaders agreed to quickly complete the content of the agreement and carry out the neccessary procedures in accordance with regulations before implementing the project as soon as possible.
