

Doctoral theses collection: including over 30,000 full text and abstracts of doctoral theses of Vietnamese people presented at home and abroad, a rare collection of the National Library of Vietnam.

Up to 2010, the National Library of Vietnam has digitization and serves library users about 1,500,000 pages (equal to 80% number of doctoral theses the library housed). Luckily, the State regulations stated that authors must submit both electronic and printed one. Doctoral theses collection is one of important digital material resource which is updated regularly.
