At the meeting, Dr. Hoang Minh Thai introduced the need to make amendments on the Constitution 1992; purposes, requirements, modified process, scopes of the Constitution and basic content of the Constitution of the Socialist Republic of Viet Nam 2013.

The 13th National Assembly of the Socialist Republic of Viet Nam at its 6th session adopted the Constitution 2013. The Constitution is divided into 11 chapters with 120 articles, one chapter and 27 articles fewer than the Constitution 1992, provision on political regimes, human rights, basic rights and duties of citizens etc. with reasonable layout, presentation techniques to ensure correct level of basic law, the long-term stability.
